Subject: Connection and Purchase Request

Lucas County Data Processing Board Members,

Lucas County Facilities began a new project many years ago to gain better control of the utilities within Lucas County owned buildings. This new project needed a sufficient network to support the addition of these new devices. It was decided that the best course of action would be to build out a new network to guarantee the integrity of both the Lucas County Data network and the Building controls network. LCIS designed and implemented the network to support the project and completed the installation in September 2012.

We are here today to request authorization to connect the Lucas County Data Network with the Facilities building controls network. The primary goal is to allow access from the key system users that reside on the Lucas County network. We will also be able to provide remote access via a secure VPN connection from untrusted networks through the public internet. This will allow Facilities personnel to respond to emergencies quickly and from virtually anywhere.

If approved, LCIS would like to move forward with a plan we have developed to connect the two networks. Our design also maintains the ability to keep either network from negatively impacting one another. The purchasing portion of this request is for a Cisco ASA Firewall and required accessories. LCIS will configure, install and test the connection while ensuring the connection is limited to only those that have the need. The total work effort for LCIS is estimated at eight hours. Once installed and configured, Facilities will remain for first point of contact for Building controls related issues, limiting reliance on LCIS resources.
