SEE NEXT PAGE FOR ADDITIONAL ITEMS TO CLARIFY SPECIFICATIONS

1. The specifications are for a particular brand of body. The County is familiar with this brand of body (Heil) and it is the basis for our selection. If another brand meets or exceeds these specifications we would consider. We want to ensure quality and ability to obtain parts.
2. The Heil body dealer for Ohio and Michigan is Bell Equipment at (866) 597-0716
3. Obtaining a timely quote from the body dealer is the responsibility of the Vendor.
4. 5 years should be the term of the lease.
5. Vendors may provide an option for the County to purchase the equipment at the end of the lease.
6. The County will not guarantee that it will purchase the equipment at the end of the lease; however, options can be presented for the County's consideration.
7. The grip strut shall be 24" inches wide from back of truck to front of truck including top door on side of truck where ladder is located. The metal type that is welded to the body is not acceptable. An acceptable material is SafetyTrac or ShurStep. It is a tape that is a sand paper type material with adhesive back and black in color.
8. Factory installation of the telma retarder is acceptable.
9. An aluminum fuel tank is acceptable.
10. The delivery time is very important as there are grant funds with timelines for the purchase of the new truck.
11. All 8 rear wheels shall be Dura Bright.
12. The front wheels shall have 12.25 x 22.5 wheels.
13. A faster rear axle ratio will not be acceptable as a change in the rear gear we will have issues with takeoff from a traffic light and hill climbing.
14. The large 8-inch rear brakes are an acceptable alternative to meet and exceed our specification.
15. Based on Telma's current recommendation of a minimum of 3000 CCA batteries, Vendors shall provide this in lieu of 1950.
16. The use of Mack front axle with grease filled bearings, not oil lubricated is acceptable.
